

HEALTH AND SAFETY AT BUTSER ANCIENT FARM SITE - A GENERAL STATEMENT

It is the policy of the (Directors/Managers) to ensure the health and safety of all persons on the site at all times. In furtherance of this the following measures have been adopted.

1. A person with specific responsibility for Health and Safety has been appointed.
2. The Safety Officer will make regular inspections and will otherwise draw the attention of the (Directors/Managers) to matters of concern at any time.
3. The Safety Officer may require the cessation of any activity, pending discussion with the (Directors/Managers).
4. All relevant Laws and Regulations concerning Health and Safety will be strictly adhered to.
5. No person under eighteen years is permitted on site except under adult supervision.
6. The Safety Officer has issued a series of advice sheets covering all aspects of work on the site. These sheets are based upon Law Regulation and good practice as identified by the Health and Safety Executive. All who work on site in whatever capacity receive these documents.
7. Training instruction and supervision are provided where necessary.
8. All Health and Safety documents will be revised as necessary at regular intervals.
9. The (Directors/Managers) will enforce 1-8 above.
